

Cookies clause

The controller of your personal data will be PHOENIX Chemicals Trading sp. z o.o. with the registered office in Warsaw, Bonifraterska Street 17.

Cookies are IT data (e.g. text files) stored on the final devices for the purpose of using the websites.

Cookies can be used to:

- a) Adjust the content of the website to your preferences,
- b) Optimise the use of the websites
- c) Create anonymous statistics that enable to understand the way of using websites by the user.

The following types of files are used:

- a) session
- b) persistent.

Session files are stored on a temporary basis, i.e. they are in the memory of a device until logging off or closing the website or a browser.

Persistent files remain in the memory of the device of the user for the time specified in the parameters of cookies or until the file has been removed by the user.

Cookies used by the website can be made available to other entities cooperating with the owner of the webpage or with an advertiser.

Internet browsers enable to place cookies in the final devices by default. Settings can be changed by the user. Detailed information about a possibility and methods of using cookies is available in settings of the Internet browser. Please be advised that limitation as regards the use of cookies may have impact on some functions available on the website.

The consent is a legal basis for personal data processing (art. 6 par. 1 lit. a of GDPR¹).

Your data will not be transferred to other recipients.

Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or an international organisation.

You can withdraw your consent to processing at any time but such withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

You have the right to:

- i. request from the controller access to your personal data and receive copies thereof;
- ii. have personal data rectified;
- iii. have personal data removed;
- iv. limit processing of personal data;
- v. object against processing;
- vi. data portability;
- vii. lodge a complaint to the Head of Personal Data Protection Office (PDPO), address: Stawki Street 2, 00 - 193 Warsaw).

Personal data will be stored for a period of 30 days, no longer than until the moment of withdrawal of consent.

The consent to personal data processing is voluntary.

Your personal data are not subject to automatic decision-making, including profiling.
